

ORDINANCE #12: REGULATING STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING

12.1 Restrictions

12.1.1 No person shall stop or park or leave standing any vehicle whether attended or unattended upon the paved or main traveled part of the East side of High Street between First and Second Street.

12.1.2 It shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle weighing in excess of three (3) ton or which has a gross weight when loaded in excess of three (3) ton to travel on High Street between Third Street and WV Route 2.

12.2 Exceptions

12.2.1 Section 12.1.1 shall not apply to the driver of any vehicle which is disabled while on the paved or main traveled portion of the highway in such manner and extent that it is impossible to avoid stopping and temporarily leaving such disabled vehicle in such position.

12.2.2. Section 12.1.2 shall not apply to school busses, garbage trucks, or emergency vehicles. Also exempt are 'box trucks' used by resident or delivery service for the transfer of furniture and/or appliances into or out of a residence at said location for the reasonable period necessary to complete said transfer.

12.3 Immediate Authorized Police Action Upon Discovery of Violation

Whenever any police officer finds a vehicle standing upon the aforesaid streets in violation of the provisions of this ordinance, such officer is hereby authorized to move such vehicle, require the driver or other person in charge of such vehicle to move the same, or to provide for the removal of such vehicle to the nearest garage at the expense of the owner of such vehicle.

12.4 Penalties

It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provision of this Ordinance, and every person convicted of such violation shall be fined as follows:

1st Offense: Not more than twenty five dollars (\$ 25.00).

2nd Offense: Not less than twenty five dollars (\$ 25.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$ 50.00).

3rd & subsequent Offenses: Not less than fifty dollars (\$ 50.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$ 100.00).

1st Reading: October 4, 2016
