

ORDINANCE 8: ELECTIONS Amendments

1. This ordinance amended to follow the State Code of WV concerning elections.
2. The filing fee for candidacy for office in the Village of Beech Bottom will be \$25.00. (nonrefundable)
3. Poll workers for the Village of Beech Bottom elections will be as follows:
 - A. All poll workers for Early Voting will be paid at the current federal minimum wage .
 - B. Poll workers for Election Day will be paid at the flat rate of \$125.00.
 - C. Election Commissioner working Election Day will be paid at the flat rate of 5150.00.
4. Elections in the Village of Beech Bottom will be conducted on the second Tuesday in June.
5. All elected offices in the Village of Beech Bottom will be for a four-year term. These offices will include Mayor, voting Recorder and five Council members.
6. When a vacancy shall occur from any cause, from any position, the position is to be filled by appointment from the council.

Re: Senate Bill 581

Senate Bill 581 was signed by the Acting Governor on April 4, 2011. This bill, effective from passage, reduces the required number of days for early voting. Early voting must now be available during normal business hours beginning on the thirteenth day preceding an election and ending on the third day preceding an election. Additionally, there must also be early voting from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on any Saturday falling within the early voting period.
