

ORDINANCE #23 CONCERNING UNLICENSED VEHICLES ON VILLAGE STREETS

SECTION 23.1: Scope:

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the Village of Beech Bottom, that no person or persons including any corporate entity shall leave any unlicensed motor vehicle of any kind or parts thereof upon any street, alley, or highway within the Village of Beech Bottom.

SECTION 23.2: Violation:

Any person or persons or corporation or unincorporated organization in violation of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall have the subject vehicle tagged by the Beech Bottom Police Department or the Mayor or his/her designee. The subject vehicle will then be towed at the owners expense after a period of seventy-two (72) hours has elapsed. Said period begins when the vehicle is tagged as previously described.

SECTION 23.3: Penalty

Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute the commission of a misdemeanor criminal offense. The fines upon conviction shall be levied as follows:

1st offense: Not less than seventy five dollars (\$75.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00)

2nd offense: Not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00)

3rd and subsequent offense: Not less than one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00)
