

ORDINANCE #26: REGULATING THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC ON SECOND STREET

26.1 Scope

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the Village of Beech Bottom that the street known as Second Street (2nd Street) be made one-way, East to West beginning at its Eastern most point at the intersection with County Route 28, and ending at its Westernmost point at the intersection with Park Avenue.

Signs indicating the traffic flow restrictions imposed by this ordinance will be posted in appropriate places.

Parking of vehicles will be permitted on both sides of the street heading East to West except at places indicated by the Village via painted curb and/or posted signage .

26.2 Exceptions

In case of emergency, fire trucks and emergency vehicles will be excluded from the provisions of this ordinance.

Motorcycles on Second Street (2nd Street) are permitted to be parked headed facing West to East for safety's sake.

26.3 Penalty for Violations

Violators of this ordinance will be prosecuted, and if convicted shall be fined as follows:

- 1st Offense: Not less than fifty dollars (\$ 50.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$ 100.00).
- 2nd Offense: Not less than one hundred dollars (\$ 100.00), nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00).
- 3rd & subsequent Offense: Not less than two hundred dollars (\$ 200.00), nor more than five hundred dollars (\$ 500.00)
